then gave us his view of the state of the criminal justice system, explaining how expensive the justice system is, and wondering where and when the costs will become too great to bear.

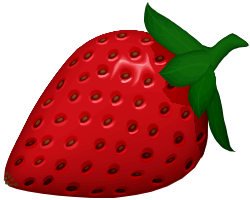

Tuesday, April 1st is the next luncheon.

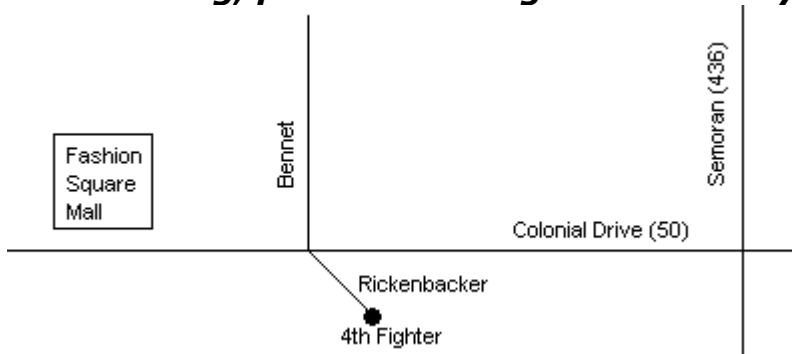
