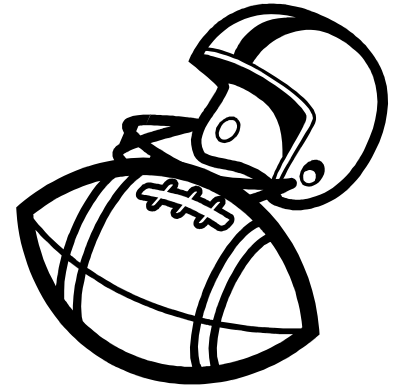


Brothers Drane, Roberts, Wuichet, and Gallagher receive their pins.

This event was organized by Brother Bill Barto, Florida Iota `95. It was a great time. I hope Bill organizes a few more of these types of events this year.

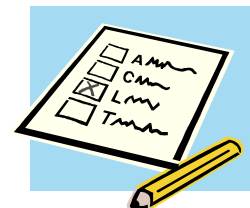
## **Renewals**
