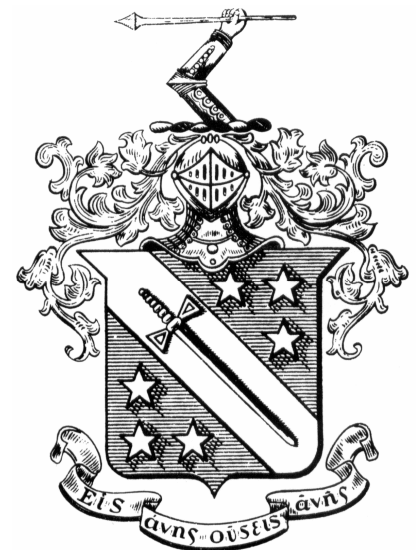

Next came the milestone recognition. A candlelight ceremony recognized the brothers who have reached milestones in their membership in Phi Delta Theta. The following brothers received pins:

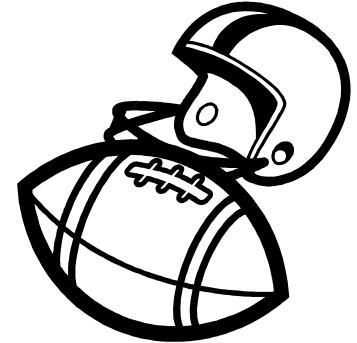
