Ed Moffit from the US Postal Inspection Service was our guest at our March luncheon. The Postal Inspection Service was founded by Benjamin Franklin, making it one of our country's oldest federal law enforcement agencies. The Postal Inspection Service has a long, proud, and successful history of fighting criminals who attack our nation's postal system and misuse it to defraud, endanger, or otherwise threaten the American public.

Postal Inspectors are federal law enforcement officers who carry firearms, make arrests and serve federal search warrants and subpoenas. Inspectors work closely with U.S. Attorneys, other law enforcement agencies, and local prosecutors to investigate postal cases and prepare them for court. There are approximately 1,970 Postal Inspectors stationed throughout the United States who enforce federal laws covering investigations of crimes that adversely affect or fraudulently use the U.S. Mail and postal system.

Ed related stories to us from his past 20+ years of experience, including being responsible for the Postal Service security at the 2002 Winter Olympics in Salt Lake City. He also gave us overviews of terrorist threats to the mail system, including the anthrax mailings in 2001.

Ed concluded his presentation with ways to avoid being a victim of fraud. The best advice is to heed the old adage, "if it's too good to be true, it probably is".
